## Conditions and Rules

### Gear check all age groups before start of first event

1. No dogs allowed on the grounds.
2. PCAQ rules apply to all events.
3. All riders compete at their own risk and in the event of injury or damage to either, horse, rider, persons or property, a rider will not hold the host club RESPONSIBLE in any way.
4. One Horse, One Rider; One Rider, One Horse rule to apply.
5. Only financial members from PCAQ affiliated clubs to compete. Please bring PCAQ Membership card as proof of membership. If you haven't received your card bring your club membership receipt.
6. One official from each club to be responsible for paying nominations and to be nominated for disputes committee.
7. Sporting cards to be handed in at time of nomination.
8. A fee of \$50.00 is to accompany any dispute, which must be lodged within 30 minutes of completion of the event concerned.
9. All competitors must wear correct club uniform including helmet of AS/NZ3838 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163 standard.
10. Excessive use of the whip, bad language, disrespect of judges or stewards and abuse of horse will all lead to disqualification.
11. The organising committee reserves the right to change the programme in any way considered necessary.
12. To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
13. Groups will be split if more than 25 riders, or combined if less than 3 riders
14. Judges decision is final.
15. In the event of a tie, a count back will decide the placing.
16. The sixty-second start rule applies.
